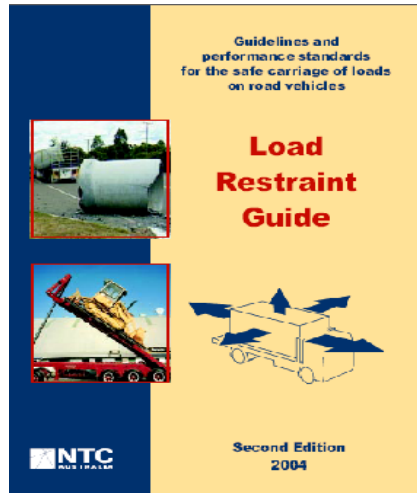

# Load Restraint Techniques



## OHSG013 Load Restraint Techniques

This 4 hour Course is designed for drivers, consignors and loaders. All drivers are responsible to ensure loads do not fall off their vehicle. National Regulations require that:

- A load on a vehicle must not be placed in a way that makes the vehicle unstable or unsafe.
- A load on a vehicle must be secured so that it is unlikely to fall or be dislodged from the vehicle.
- An appropriate method must be used to restrain the load on a vehicle.

The Course is a Duty of Care short course designed to meet WHS Obligations for training and covers the following topics:

- Legislation Responsibilities
- Direct Restraint Methods
- Load Distribution
- Load Restraint Guide
- Forces Causing Movement
- Load Securing Equipment
- Load Limitations
- Practical Tie Down Methods
