WHS017 Vehicle Loading Crane Operation

A vehicle Loading Crane is a crane mounted on a vehicle for the principal purpose of loading and unloading the vehicle it is mounted on. A High Risk Work Licence Class CV is required for operators of Vehicle Loading Cranes when the crane has a capacity of 10 metre tonnes or more.

This 6 hour course is designed for operators of Vehicle Loading Cranes with a capacity of less than 10 metre tonnes. The Course is a Duty of Care short course designed to assist duty holders to meet WHS obligations for training and covers the following topics:

- Site Hazards
- Crane Signals
- Maintenance
- Safe Operation
- Personal Protective Equipment
- Job Planning
- Pre-Operational Checks
- Crane Set Up
- Slings and Load Handling
- Practical Operation of Crane

Cost per person is \$550.00 incl gst, participants will be issued with a Statement of Attendance and a durable plastic card upon completion.

The Course is normally run in two sessions:

Session 1:

Four hours duration, covering practical set-up and operation including the underpinning knowledge required for Vehicle Loading Crane Operations. Upon completion, participants will be issued with a training Log Book and study material. Participants will then work under supervision in the workplace as a trainee until they are ready to be assessed. It will be expected that candidates for assessment will have 40 hours practical operation recorded in their Log Book prior to assessment.

Session 2:

Two hours duration, [Practical and Theory Assessment]. Upon successful completion, participants will be issued with a Statement of Attendance and a Durable Plastic Photo ID Style Card Class VLC.
